Standish is an ancient parish in the Diocese of Gloucester; the ecclesiastical parish of Whiteshill was formed from Standish and Stroud in 1844. Standish has been united with Eastington, Frocester, Haresfield, Moreton Valence and Whitminster since 1999: the six parishes form one benefice known as "The Cotswold Edge Parishes"
